

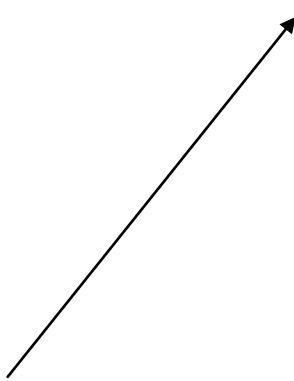


## European Union Overview II

| CFSP | Launched in 1970 its primary aim is to establish the EU's fishing grounds as a common resource.  |
| CAP  | Developed in 2004 it offers EU neighbours a privileged relationship with the EU and closer co-operation in important policy areas.   |
| ESDP | A system of agricultural subsidies and programmes, intended to ensure a fair standard of living for the agricultural community.  |
| CFP  | Framed by the Treaty of Nice in 2000 this policy enables the EU to engage actively in crisis management and provide a means of integrated defence for the Union.               |
| JHA  | Established in 1997 in an attempt to establish a presence in international affairs, in conformity with the United Nations Charter.   |
| ENP  | Implemented by the European Council, this policy aims to fight criminal activity across national borders through intergovernmental cooperation and supranational institutions. |
